What will you decorate it with?

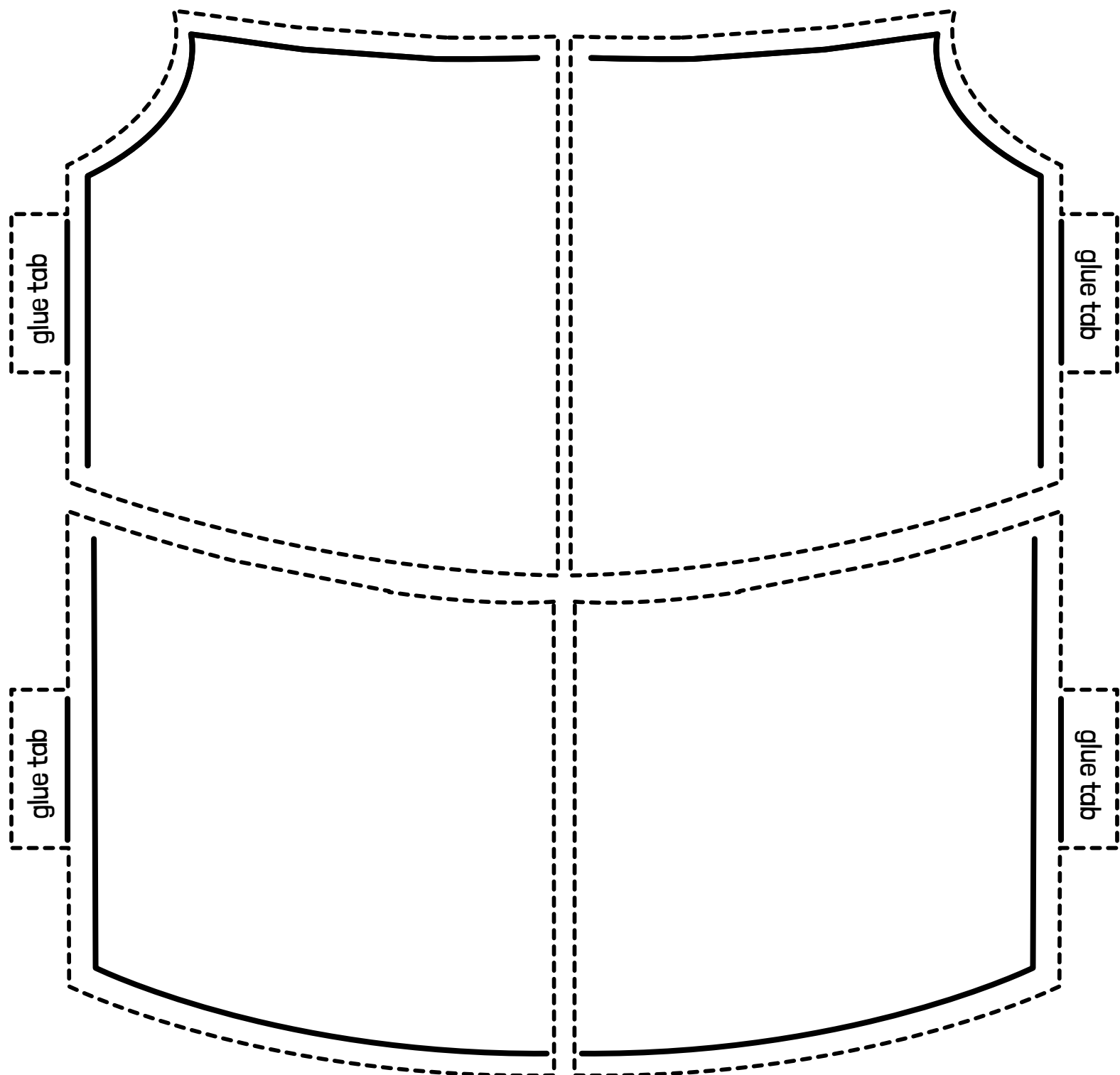
Pencils? Pens? Glitter? Paint?
